Show Rules

The American Boar Goat Association (ABGA) sanctions this show and its rules shall govern. All goats must be registered and have their ABGA papers for entry into this show....

- Base date for computing animal's age is August 16, 2019.
- A registration certificate is required for all animals. Tattoos must be legible and match the registration paper. Microchipping is also acceptable as long as it is permanently on registration papers (not sticker) and filed with ABGA. Your own reader in working order is required to read the chip. Any animal whose tattoo or chip is illegible, unreadable, or incorrect will be disqualified.
- All goats must have a current health certificate. It is the owner's responsibility to conform to all interstate transport laws.
- Registration certificate and current health papers must be presented to show secretary prior to show.
- You may arrive on Thursday, August 15, 2019 and can check in for the show starting 4:00 pm.
- Animals must be in place and checked-in by 1:00 p.m. on Friday, August 16. Animals must vacate the barn by 7:00 a.m., August 17, no exceptions next livestock show needs pens....
- NO DOGS ALLOWED even herding dogs. Animals not being shown are prohibited. Pens are on a first come first serve basis. Pens are not to be used for displays or tack.
- The show director or his representative will inspect all animals and will bar from the grounds any animal that is obviously sick, diseased, or parasite infected.
- The show committee reserves the right to set reasonable standards for conduct by the exhibitors.
- All livestock exhibitors and drivers of vehicles transporting livestock will be admitted **FREE**. An exhibitor is defined as the person who attends the animal in the show.
- The Wilson County Fair promoters and members of the show committee will not be responsible for animals, personal property, accidents, and/or injury.

Entry Fee: \$12.00 per head if entered by August 13 (after August 10 - \$20.00 per head)

Pen Fee: \$5 per pen (2 goats per/pen if possible)

Out of state exhibitors may remain in area overnight, however they must leave no later than 7:00 a.m. Saturday, 17 Aug.
